Dr. Brian Parker is a clinical sexologist and sex educator with a Ph. D. and an Ed. D. in Human Sexuality from The Institute for Advanced Study of Human Sexuality in San Francisco. He is the co-owner of Forever Pleasure and Copulus, Inc. Forever Pleasure was conceived when the owners identified a need for sex-positive, informative sex education and high-end products on the World Wide Web. The owners decided to offer at-home Forever Pleasure Parties to help Edmontonians improve their sexual self-esteem and promote happy and healthy sensual relationships.

Copulus, Inc. creates relationship tools for intimate couples. The company has two intimacy board games currently on the market, created by Dr. Parker and Allan Harms. “Embrace” is a sensually stimulating board game for lovers that can be played on three levels: Romantic, Sexual Intimacy, and Hot Sex. “Pillow Talk: The Sensual Relationship Game” uses sexuality as the framework to help couples resolve problematic relationship issues such as money, in-laws, and jealousy.

Christopher Spencer of the Edmonton Journal wrote that Dr. Brian Parker went from “international sex symbol to Edmonton’s sex guru,” since he was an international model for ten years before giving it all up to become a sex expert.

During his years as an international model, Dr. Brian lived in major fashion cities around the world. He modeled for numerous clients including; *Paul Smith*, *Esquire* magazine, *Marie Claire*, *Heineken*, and *Pepsi*.

Over the past three years, Dr. Brian has given lectures on various areas of human sexuality in Edmonton, Calgary, Toronto, Guelph, Halifax, and San Francisco. He currently works for Planned Parenthood Edmonton as a sexual health educator and counsellor. He teaches sex-ed to junior and high school students and often guest lectures at the University of Alberta and Grant MacEwan Community College.
